The Boys & Girls Club of Appleton's 2017 Summer Program will begin on Thursday, June 8th and continue through August 17th.

Course Descriptions

Art Enrichment: Learn how to draw, paint, and sketch the world around you! We'll create exciting art projects that you will want to share with your family and friends.

So, You Think You Can Dance! Start dancing to your favorite song while learning new show-stopping moves. You will also have an exciting time creating moves of your own and pumping up the crowd with your new routines.

Group Games: Kids will enjoy participating in a variety of unique and creative games designed to teach problem solving, teamwork, and leadership.

SPARK: Come play jump rope games, parachute play, jogging games, fitness circuits, beanbag activities, and more.

Grossology: The science of all things gross! This program explores the slimy, oozy, scaly, and stinky gross (yet scientific) things that occur every day in the human body. Based on the children's best-selling book "Grossology" by Sylvia Branzei.

Multi-Cultural Art: Explore the importance of artistic expression in different cultures. Learn how to make native crafts as you explore their various histories.

Junk Box Wars: Come use your imagination, scientific knowledge, and a box of "junk" to create a variety of devices that perform an assortment of tasks. The Junk Box Wars projects are modeled after the Junkyard Wars TV show.

ImageMakers: If you love to take photos, come learn and practice black and white photos, color and the digital process of photography.

Sport-a-Week: A different sport will be taught and explored each week, including volleyball, basketball, baseball, and more.
