**Travis Thor Receives \$4,000 Educational Scholarship**

**Appleton, WI (November 14, 2017)** – The Boys & Girls Clubs of the Fox Valley today names Travis Thor the 2017-2018 Youth of the Year, the organization’s most prestigious Boys & Girls Club member award. Thor will receive a \$4,000 scholarship for post-secondary education and will represent the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Fox Valley at the Wisconsin Youth of the Year competition in Green Bay in March, 2018.

Thor has been a Boys & Girls Club member for nine years and has given more than 100 hours of volunteer service this year to members of the Boys & Girls Club of Wilson Middle School. He is 16 years old and a Junior at Renaissance School for the Arts. Thor plans to attend a four-year university to major in performing arts with a minor in mathematics.
